



MUNICIPAL HALL

The Municipal Hall was provided with a versatile and multi-use entrance foyer, whose center with a 14-metre high airspace is the focal point of the design. From two main stairways the observer's view is guided to a larger-than-life screen. The integration of a rear projection technology and the semi-transparent surface makes it possible to see the streams of people moving behind the screen. A giant, vivid cylinder grips the room over the gastronomy unit in the southern part of the foyer. The deliberately reserved use of materials helps provide an event-related decor through the accentuation of light effects.
